Advocating for public ownership of the new National Maternity Hospital and better maternity care as we emerge from the pandemic

## Oireachtas Bills I am working on

**Reproductive Health Related Leave Bill 2021** – I have brought forward legislation to provide for paid leave of up to 20 days for women who suffer an early miscarriage, and up to 10 days for employees receiving treatments such as IVF.

Renters' Rights Bill 2021 – With my colleague Senator Rebecca Moynihan, I have introduced legislation to address security of tenure, unaffordable rents and deposits, and quality of rental accommodation. It would restrict the situations in which a tenancy can be ended; limit deposits to one month's rent; and allow renters to keep a pet and to rent unfurnished homes.

**Dublin Bay Bill 2021** – I have published a Bill to establish a statutory Dublin Bay Taskforce, charged with preserving for future generations the distinctive character of Dublin Bay, protecting its ecology as a coastal resource, and enhancing it as an accessible public amenity.

**Naturalisation of Minors Born in Ireland Bill** – My Bill to provide for greater access to citizenship for all children born in Ireland to non-national parents is currently at Committee Stage in the Seanad.

**Carbon Footprint Labelling Bill 2021** – This Bill would compel companies to disclose the carbon footprint of their products sold in Ireland by obliging the National Standards Authority to define a standard approach to carbon labelling.

**Period Products (Free Provision) Bill 2020** - This Bill would make period products free in all schools, educational facilities and public service buildings.

#### Platform Workers and Bogus Self-Employment Bill 2021

- This Bill would give platform workers in the gig economy who work for companies such as Deliveroo access to increased workers' rights and protections.

**Autism Empowerment Strategy Motion** – Labour's motion to introduce a National Autism Empowerment Strategy recently passed the Dáil, addressing the lengthy delays experienced by many families seeking assessments for children and the profound shortage of school places for children with autism – a significant issue across Dublin Bay South.

#### **Local News**

 Since my election in July, I have met with a range of different local community groups and organisations and have made many representations on behalf of individual constituents. In particular, I have received many calls from individual constituents experiencing housing difficulties, and problems obtaining passports and EU Digital Covid Certificates. Please do contact me if you would like me to meet with your own local group or to take up other issues on your behalf.

Here are just some of the local issues on which I am working:

- Cllr. Mary Freehill and I have been lobbying the
  Department of Defence to ensure that local sports clubs
  will have greater access to the playing fields at Cathal
  Brugha Barracks Rathmines. I have also been working with
  local sports clubs in the Ringsend/Irishtown area to ensure
  greater provision of public green spaces for use by our
  communities.
- I have been in contact with the Ministers for Education and Special Education seeking urgent action to tackle the recent rejection of significant numbers of local schools' applications for SNA allocation.
- I have written to the Minister for Social Protection following reports that multiple in-person Citizens Information services in Dublin Bay South are facing closure. These are indispensable services which must be protected.
